

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Equitable Distribution



Equitable distribution has been defined as the distribution of health professionals in communities to ensure accessibility to appropriate health care by appropriate health professionals in an appropriate time-frame.


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FROM HOPE TO ACTION THROUGH KNOWLEDGE

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- Ensures that individuals with more compromised health conditions will receive more health services
- Commitment to health equity
- Availability of health services - major concern
- Access to health care
- Horizontal equity - “equal access for equal needs”
 - equal resources
 - equal access to health care
 - equal utilization of health services
 - equal health




FROM HOPE TO ACTION THROUGH KNOWLEDGE

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- Vertical equity
 - unequal should be treated in proportion of their inequality
- Individuals with more need should have more treatment
- The central theme of “need” therefore determines equity
- Aspects of equity in health and health care
 - Equity in access to health care
 - Equity in health
 - Effective coverage



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Arising need during Pandemic



- 2009 influenza A(H1N1) pandemic
- The development and widespread distribution of COVID-19 medical treatments are a common global interest.
- COVID-19 has caused a scarcity of medical resources
Achieving global, equitable access to COVID-19 vaccines and therapeutics will be difficult.
- Therefore there is an opportunity for Equitable distribution

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Framework for Distribution



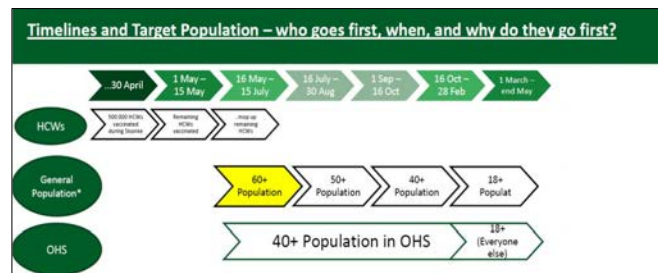
- Flexible, trusted governance

- Open collaboration and evidence-based, Health-driven allocation



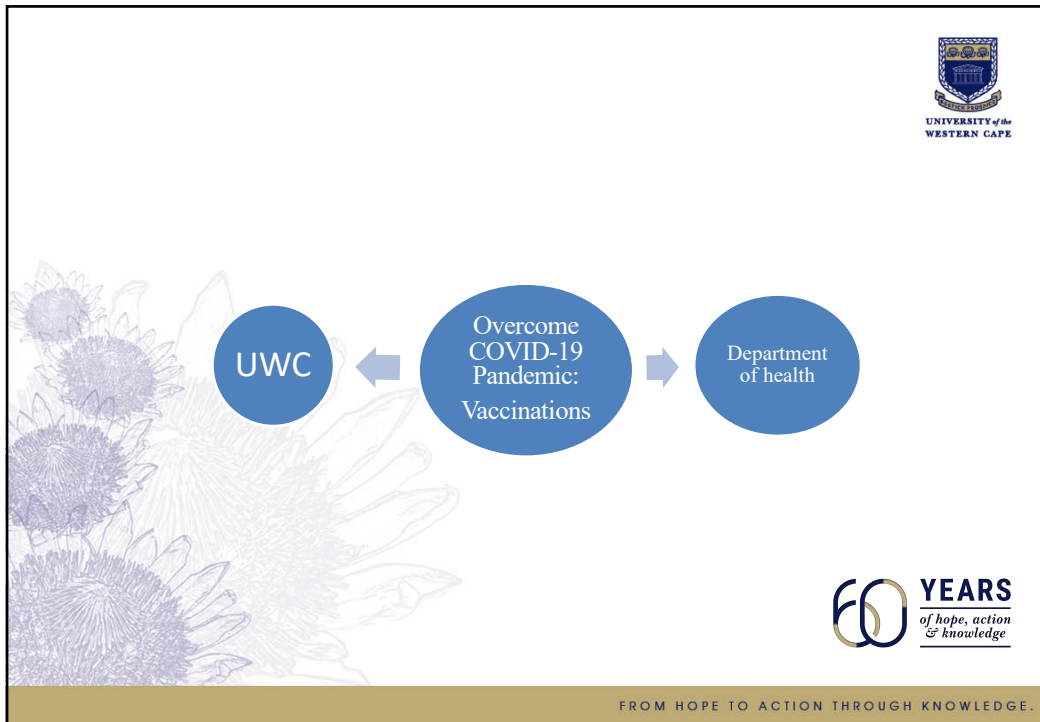

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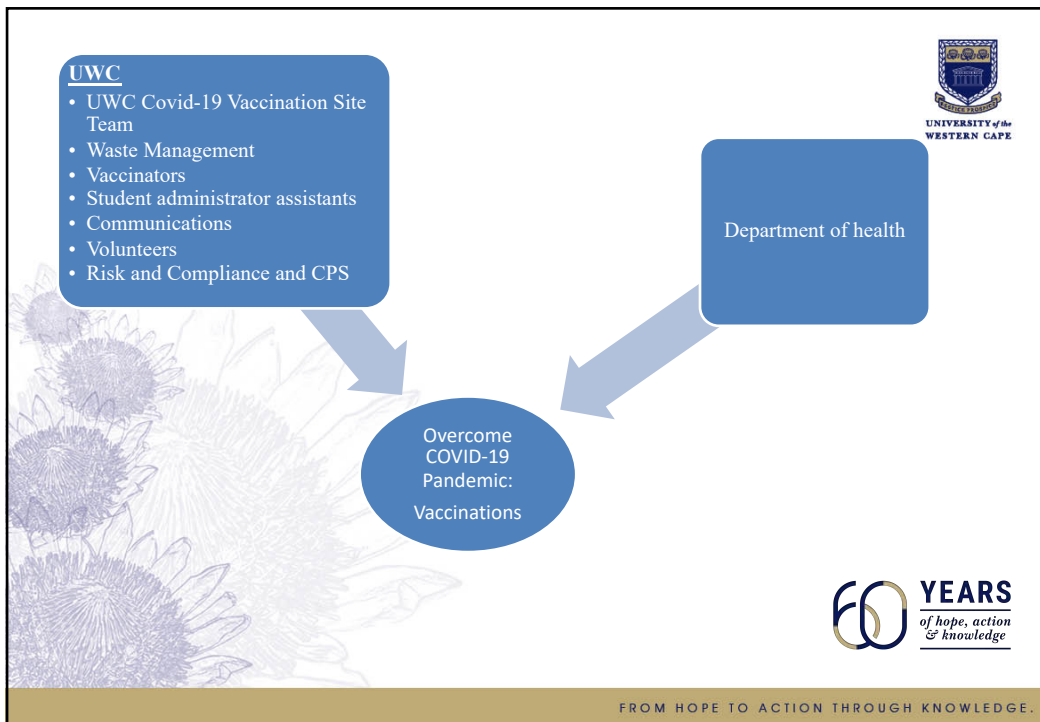
- **Goal:** To provide effective, efficient and overall amazing experience to all patients receiving vaccination.

- All receiving the same, fair treatment



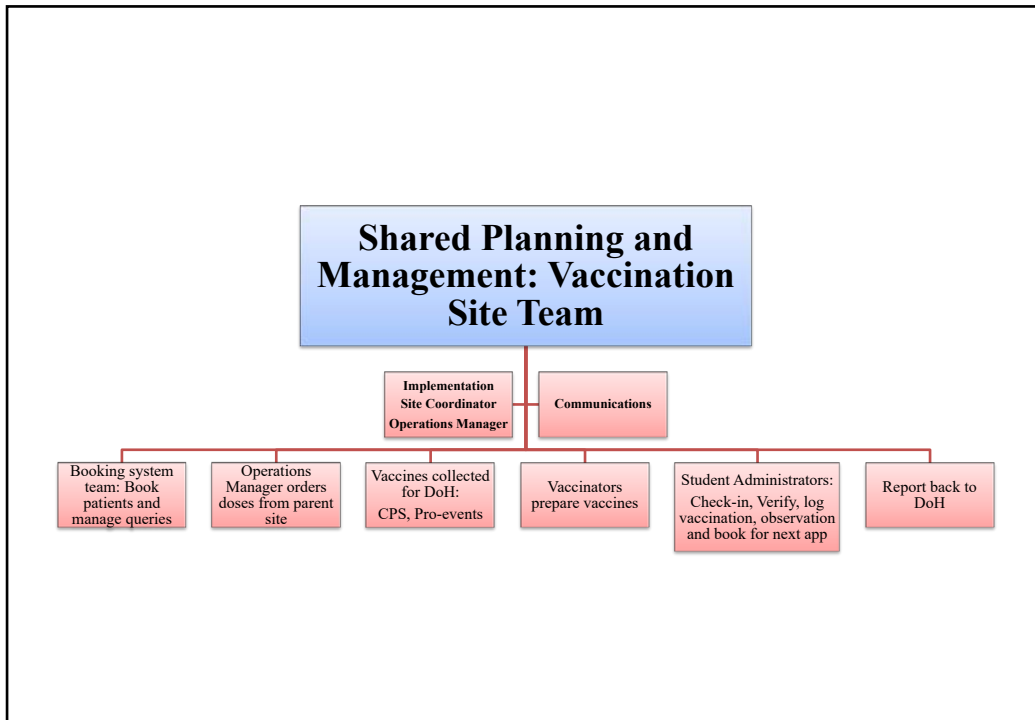
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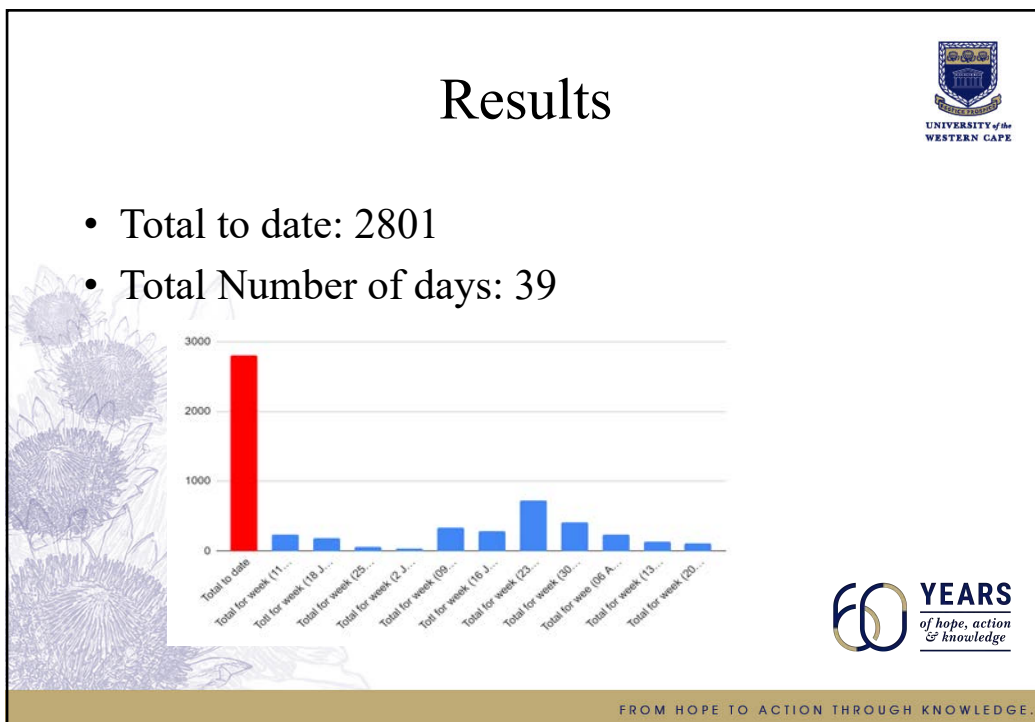
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
