Key Challenges remain to achieving the PHC vision

"The most pressing gap is the chronic underfunding of PHC. Typically, only 40% of national health budgets are going to PHC despite PHC covering more than 80% of health needs."

Insufficient financing for PHC

"We have neglected the need to address a full set of issues facing local populations and instead focused on diseases instead of patient wellbeing in a holistic sense."
